What is AusGeoTIFF?

AusGeoTIFF's are raster images of the Australian Navigation Chart Series in GeoTIFF format.

How can AusGeoTIFF be used?

AusGeoTIFF was developed to provide a chart image backdrop for use in Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and image viewing systems. However, it can be used for any application provided that it is not used for navigational purposes.

What is available?

The complete Australian Navigation Chart Series is available in AusGeoTIFF format. You may order the complete chart series or individually select the charts to match your own requirements. In addition a number of update services are available to enable you to keep your charts up to date for Notices to Mariners (NtM) updates.

The images are provided under a licensing agreement each user is supplied with a unique licence number. Site Licenses are also available, for more information; see *Site Licensing* in *Brochure 2, Application Conditions*.

Where do I get AusGeoTIFF?

AusGeoTIFF is only available from the Australian Hydrographic Office. To request AusGeoTIFF images you will need to complete a AusGeoTIFF Application Form. You can obtain a copy of the form from the Licensing section of our website or

What does it cost?

AusGeoTIFF prices are based on the number of charts you select. For example, one chart will cost \$389 & 50 charts will cost \$903. For more information, see *Brochure 4, Pricing*.
